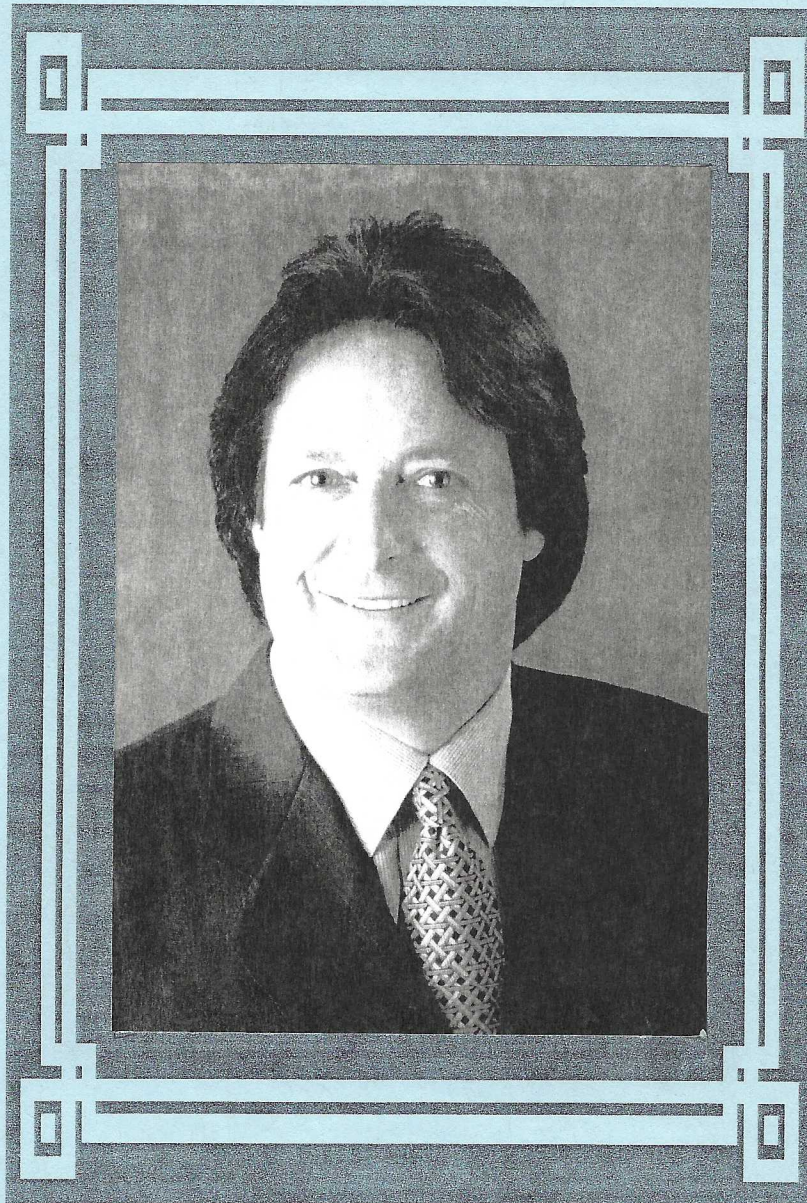

Mark Tinchler graduated from Plattsmouth High School in 1976. Mark has been married to Kathryn D. Mark graduated from the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1979 with a Bachelors Degree in Business Administration with an emphasis on Finance and Real Estate.

Mark started his career as a car salesman in 1980. He acquired part ownership of a GM Dealership in 1982 and has continued expanding ownership opportunities. Mark's **Tinchler Auto Mall** consists of 4 dealership locations, with 6 franchises: Chevrolet, Ford, Mercury, Chrysler, Dodge, and Jeep. In addition, he owns **Tinchler Collision Center**, an auto body repair center and **Siebert & Associates**, a mobility conversion company for handicapped accessible vehicles. The mobility company is located in Glenwood and Des Moines and has recently expanded to a new location in Little Rock, AR.

Mark also owns and operates 4 companies unrelated to the car industry. **Tinchler Investments** is a land development corporation that creates acreage subdivisions in a residential setting bringing new people to live in the area. **Tinchler Farms** is a row-crop farming operation spanning Cass and Otoe County, Nebraska and Mills County, Iowa. **Mid-America Motorplex** is a driving facility on a 217-acre tract located at I-29 & Pacific Junction, Iowa featuring a 2.23-mile road course and a 1/8 mile drag strip. **Asphalt Solutions** is an asphalt construction company located at a newly erected batch plant 2 miles north of Plattsmouth. Mark partners with other local entrepreneurs in real estate and residential land development. He has part ownership of a ranch in New Mexico. Collectively he employs over 150 full time and part time employees from the local area.
